WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE THE BODY OF CHRIST?

Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.
-1 Corinthians 12:27

Dear People of Christ,

The Apostle Paul wrote at the beginning of his letter to the Philippians: *"I thank my God in all my remembrance of you..."* Brothers and sisters of Christ Church, I want you to know that I feel the same about all of you.

In the time I have been your pastor, I have been inspired by your faith...impressed by your perseverance... and blessed greatly by your love. And, like Paul, I do give thanks every day for the privilege of walking beside you as we grow closer to Jesus.

I realize the path has not been easy over the past decade. Our church is not like it once was. Sadly, that is true for a lot of churches in these times. Our challenges are real...daunting even. And the path ahead is just as rocky and steep as ever. And sometimes the best we can do is simply to be FAITHFUL.

That said, as the little song goes, *"The church is not a building...the church is people."* It's you and me, all of us who make up Christ's living Body right here. Folks, we are Christ Church together.

What does it mean to be the Body of Christ? Paul laid it out for the Christians at Corinth when he likened the church to the human body—Christ's body. He says that we each have been given a gift to share in making the body healthy. These variety of gifts come from the Spirit...and each is needful for the body to function.

Think of our church...see the faces of those who sit around you every Sunday...recall the recent times of fellowship and serving together... remember our special times of joy and celebration. And then say a prayer of gratitude for these blessings.

Not just what it was in the past, but what it is in the present. I'm talking about what is happening among us now... and the joy of just being together.

Yes, we are a small church. But from everything I have seen, we sure do have a big heart for serving Jesus. And really, isn't that what it is all about in being His Body on earth? In offering to Him ourselves—our talents, gifts, presence, prayers, witness?

Like I said, I am so grateful...to each of you. I'm not sure our church would be here today if not for each of you...and the countless "sacrifices" you have made, and continue to make. The truth is we are doing great ministry together. We are practicing "radical hospitality" in hosting the mission work teams. We are serving and witnessing in our community weekly. We are providing holy space for others outside our church. And we are doing a lot more.

But it isn't just about all that we are doing...it's more about who we are as Christ's people. Loving members of his Body. Each having a privileged role...and a special place...and the calling Jesus lays on our hearts. All of which, by the way, makes us a HOLY COMMUNION.

Jesus often taught in parables. Here is a parable from centuries ago. It's the story of a wealthy nobleman in a village in the Alps who truly loved and cared about the people. A devout Christian, he realized they had outgrown their tiny church, and besides it needed a lot of repairs. So, after much prayer, he felt that God was calling him to build a new church for the village.

Work began, and the people were glad that they would have a beautiful place for all of them to worship together. Finally, the church was finished... and as they stepped inside for the first time, they were awed by its beauty. But then, someone asked: *"Where are the lamps?"* The stained glass let in some light, but it was still rather dark inside.

The nobleman smiled and pointed to the brackets on the walls. Then he handed out a beautiful lamp to each family and told them they were to bring it whenever they came to church. *"When you are here,"* he said to them, *"your place will be lit. When you are not here it will be dark. This, my friends, is to be a reminder of how each of you are precious to God, and what it means to be the Body of Christ and his light to the world."*

Dear folks, as we make our plans for the Fall and beyond, the challenges remain. Sometimes they can seem overwhelming; and they would be if we were alone. But we are not alone. Together, we are the living Body of Christ!

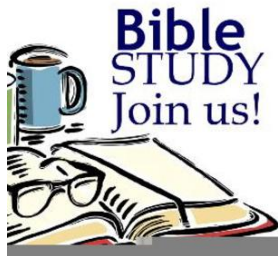
